NB:

- All S.2, S.3, S.4 & S.6 students are expected to report to school **dressed in full school uniform**.
- Reporting time is 9:00am – 5:00pm
- Ensure that your son leaves home early so as to beat the time set. **NO** student will be allowed in school after 5:00pm.

2. SCHOOL FEES FOR TERM 1 2022

Please pay your son's fees using the student's Identification Number (SIN)

For S.1 and S.5 students, pay your son's fees using the banking slip issued by the Admission officer.

NB: All students with outstanding fees balances of 2020/2021 **MUST** pay the same before reporting to school.

3. SCHOOL REQUIREMENTS

All students should report to school with the following items;

1. A ream of photocopying paper(ROTATRIM-500sheets)
2. Enough sanitizer to last the term
3. 4grey fabric(reusable) masks
4. Vitamin C tablets (10strips)
5. Zinc tablets (5strips)
6. All personal requirements to last a term.

NB:

There will be checking at the entrance, so as to be on the safe side ensure that your son has all the above requirements.

4. VISITING DAY

There will be no visiting day. This is according to the guidelines of the Ministry of Health and Ministry of Education and sports. Ensure your son has enough personal effects and pocket money to last him a term. Prepare him to accept the new normal.

5. HEATH

- In the bid to keep COVID-19 at bay, we shall enforce the COVID-19 SOPs. Prepare your son to follow the SOPs if he cares about his health, the others health and his studies. **No complacency** will be tolerated.
